Applications will be accepted through the Texas Workforce Center office located at 246 Homer Taylor Drive or you may apply online at <u>www.sweetwatertx.gov</u>. All applications must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 8, 2024.

At present time there are two positions available.

Qualifications

- Applicants must be 21 years old with a maximum age of 44 years. Documentation must be provided.
- Must be high school graduate or have equivalent GED.
- Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License and have a satisfactory background driving record and pass a background investigation.
- Must be able to read and write the English language.
- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- Preferably possess certification as a peace officer as established by Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) at time of examination. Applicant shall provide evidence of certification on or before date of entrance examination.
- If applicant served in the armed forces of the United States, a DD-214 must be produced with application.
- Must be physically sound free from any defect, which may adversely affect his/her performance of duty.
- The resulting hire list will be effective for six months.
