Brush/limbs	The DOC accepts limbs measuring 4 feet or less in the designated dumpster. The Landfill accepts any length of limbs. NO CHARGE.
Lumber	DOC accepts limbs measuring 4 feet or less in the assigned dumpster. The landfill will accept any length of lumber. NO CHARGE FOR CITY RESIDENTS. BUSINESS/CONTRACTORS AND NON-CITY RESIDENTS SEE FEES ABOVE.
Furnishings, Carpet	DOC or Landfill. NO CHARGE FOR CITY RESIDENTS. BUSINESS/CONTRACTORS AND NON-CITY RESIDENTS SEE FEES ABOVE.
Construction/Demolition debris	1] Landfill in small or large quantities 2] DOC small quantities only NO CHARGE FOR CITY RESIDENTS WITH WATER BILL STUB & BUILDING PERMIT. BUSINESS/CONTRACTORS AND NON-CITY RESIDENTS SEE FEES ABOVE.
Metal, Metal appliances	1] Landfill will accept metal in a metal bin. NO CHARGE. 2] DOC. NO CHARGE. *No appliances containing special waste, i.e., oils, fuels, freon, etc., is allowed, These should be taken directly to the local salvage yard.
Clean Dirt	The Landfill will accept dirt that is not contaminated by petroleum products. NO CHARGE.
Glass: Bottles/Jars	Only the DOC will accept bottles/jars. Must be clean, with tops removed, separate colors [clear, green, and brown glass], labels OK left on. NO CHARGE. No window glass, mirrors, ceramics, or light bulbs.

Food and Drink Cans	Only the DOC accepts cans. Must be cleaned. Labels OK left on. NO CHARGE. No paint cans, aerosols, etc.
Cardboards/Paper	DOC only. Clean mixed paper. Corrugated/"flat" cardboard, flattened, stables and tape removed. No plastic or was coated cardboard. NO CHARGE.
Tires	DOC only. Please remove rims. Each resident is allowed 4 passenger tires per year at NO CHARGE.
DO-It-Yourself Oil, Oil Filters/Cans	DOC used automotive oil, oil filters, and oil cans from individuals NO CHARGE. *No dealers or garages.
Putrescible/Household Wastes	DOC only. Staff will direct to proper bins for disposal of material. NO CHARGE for City residents presenting water bill stub at the gate. *All others see fees above.
