


**CITY OF SWEETWATER, TEXAS

The City Council of the City of Sweetwater, Texas, will meet in regular session on Tuesday, October 8, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. in the City Council Chambers of the City Hall, 200 E. 4th Street, Sweetwater, TX.

4. City Council to discuss, consider and act upon approval of minutes for meetings held on September 10, 2019, September 17, 2019, and September 24, 2019.

  - B. City Council to discuss, consider and act upon reappointments of Mr. Ray Chittum, Ms. Cheri Roden, and Mr. Keith Clower, whose terms will expire October 2021, as Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Sweetwater.
  - C. City Council to discuss, consider and act upon reappointments of Mr. Charles Hamlin, Mr. Kerry Baker, and Ms. JoAnn French as board members, and appointment of Mr. Gil Cherry as alternate to the Planning and Zoning Commission, with terms expiring September 2021.
