- 1. Mayor McKenzie called the meeting to order.

- 3. Mayor Pro Tem Peek led the pledge of allegiance.
- 4. A. City Commission heard from Nancy Johnson and Tommy Morris of the Tommy Morris Agency concerning the proposals received August 11, 2017, on Group Health, Dental and Life Insurance Employee Benefit FY 2017-2018. After discussing options and projections, motion was made by Commissioner May, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peek to stay with selffunded plan and keep BlueCross BlueShield as administrator. The motion carried unanimously.

Co. Survey, Nolan County, Texas.

C. Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Peek, seconded by Commissioner Lee to approve Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2017-07 creating the boundaries of the Sweetwater Municipal Development District; ordering a special municipal election on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 for the City of Sweetwater, Texas and its extraterritorial jurisdiction, for the purpose of proposing to the voters the authorizing of the City of Sweetwater Municipal Development District and authorizing the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of one-half of one percent for the purpose of financing development projects beneficial to the district; designating the location and time for early voting; and establishing an effective date. Commissioner May opposed and Mayor McKenzie, Mayor Pro Tem Peek, Commissioner Castro and Commissioner Lee were all in favor.
