CITY COUNCIL MINUTES March 9, 2021 9:00 A.M.

The City Council of the City of Sweetwater, Texas, met in regular session on Tuesday, March 9, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. via GoToMeeting videoconferencing in Sweetwater, TX and had the following members present:

- 1. Mayor McKenzie called the meeting to order.
- 2. Councilman May gave the invocation.
- 3. Sweetwater Intermediate School Student Council representatives led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American and the Texas Flags.
- 4. Motion was made by Councilman May, seconded by Councilman Castro to approve the minutes for meeting held on February 9, 2021. The motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Public Input: None

This meeting was closed to in person attendance by the public. A temporary suspension of certain provisions of the Open Meetings Act to allow telephone or videoconference public meetings was granted by Governor Greg Abbott. These actions were taken to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people into a group setting and in accordance with Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code.

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- 7. Sweetwater Intermediate School student council representatives, made a presentation regarding the benefits of allowing "backyard chickens" in the City of Sweetwater.
- 8. Regular Agenda Items
 - A. Motion was made by Councilman Castro, seconded by Councilman Baker to approve an Ordinance amending Chapter 6, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sweetwater entitled "Animals and Fowl". The motion carried four (4) aye and one (1) abstention.

Mayor Pro Tem Peek abstained.
